NOTIFICATION

Maharashtra Public University Act - 2016

RNI No. MAHBIL/2009/35530 In exercise of the powers conferred by section 34 (2) of the Maharashtra Public University Act 2016, dated 11 January 2017 the Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad hereby makes the following rules to regulate admissions to the First Year of Full Time Post Graduate Technical & Non - Technical Courses:-

01. Faculty of Science & Technology.
02. Faculty of Commerce & Management.
03. Faculty of Humanities.
04. Faculty of Interdisciplinary namely:-

01 Short title and commencement:-

- I These rules may be called the, Post Graduate Technical & Non - Technical Courses, Admission Rules for Admission Process 2019.
- II They shall come into force from2019.

02 Definitions:-

- I In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires:-
 - a "Act" means the Maharashtra Public University Act 2016;
 - b "Admission Reporting Centre" means a centre where the Candidate shall report for confirmation of admission by verification of documents;
 - c "Application Form" means prescribed form filled up online by the Candidate for admission to Post Graduate Courses;
 - d "Autonomous Departments" means an institution to which autonomy is granted by the University Grants Commission;
 - e "Courses" mean the Post Graduate Technical & Non - Technical Courses. Faculty of Science & Technology, Faculty of Commerce & Management, Faculty of Humanities & Faculty of Interdisciplinary.
 - f "Eligible Candidates" means the candidates who are eligible for different Post Graduate Courses as notified by the University/ Government, from time to time;
 - g "Facilitation Centre" means a centre where the facilities like sale of application kits, filling online forms, verification of documents and grievances, etc, are provided;
 - h "Foreign Student" means a student who is not a citizen of India;
 - i "Home University (HU)" means the area under the jurisdiction of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad;
 - j "HSC" means the Higher Secondary School Certificate (Standard XII) examination conducted by Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent certificate awarded by recognised Boards;
 - k "Inter-Se-Merit" means the order of merit declared by the Competent Authority in respect of various classes/ category of Candidates;
 - l "Overseas Citizen of India" means a Candidate/ person registered as an overseas citizen of India as declared by the Central Government under Section 7A of the Citizenship Act, 1955 and includes Persons of Indian Origin.
 - m Explanation: For the purposes of this clause, all the existing Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) cardholders registered under notification of the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs No. F. No. 26011/04/98- F. I, dated 19th August 2002 and shall now be deemed to be Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) card holders by virtue of Notification of Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, No. 25024/9/2014-F.I., dated 9th January 2015.
 - n "OHU" means the area Outside the jurisdiction of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad;
 - o "Qualifying Examination" means the examination on the basis of which a Candidate becomes eligible for admission to the Post Graduate Courses or its equivalent examination;
 - p "SSC" means the Secondary School Certificate (Standard 'X') examination conducted by Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent certificate awarded by a recognised Boards;
 - q "Supernumerary Seats" means seats which are over and above the Sanctioned Intake



approved by the appropriate authority and/or the Government, from time to time.

- r Words and expressions used but not defined in these rules shall have the same meanings respectively assigned to them in the Act.

03 **Invitation of Application.-**

- I The University shall invite Online Applications from Candidates:-

- a for participating in Entrance Test for seeking admission to the Post Graduate Courses for which Entrance Test is required for the academic year 2019-2020.

04 **Eligibility:-**

- I The eligibility criterion for admission to various Post Graduate Technical & Non-Technical courses is as given below:- (*Online Application on University portal is only for University Department Courses Only*)

A **Faculty of Science & Technology**

Master of Science [02 year course]

- a 1] Physics,
2] Zoology,
3] Microbiology,
4] Electronics, A Candidate shall be admitted to the First Year Course for the Master's Degree in the Faculty of Science provided that he passed the B.Sc. degree examination of this University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto, the subject in which he seeks admission at M.Sc. being one of the Optional subjects at Bachelor's degree level.
- b 1] Botany A Candidate shall be admitted to the First Year Course for the Master's Degree in the Faculty of Science provided that he passed the B.Sc. degree examination of this University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto, the subject in which he seeks admission at M.Sc. being one of the Optional subjects at Bachelor's degree level.
The students of B.Sc. [Agriculture] be considered eligible for admission to **M.Sc.[Botany]** and that **only Two Seats be reserved for such admission**
- c 1] Chemistry,
2] Bio-Chemistry, A candidate's choice of subject for the M.Sc. Course examination shall be restricted to one of the subjects offered at the Bachelor's Degree Examination. Provided that a candidate who has passed Bachelor's Degree Examination, Provided that a candidate who has passed the Bachelor's degree examination.
With Chemistry OR Bio-Chemistry OR Industrial Chemistry OR Analytical Chemistry OR Agro Chemical and fertilizers shall be eligible for admission to **M.Sc. in either Chemistry OR Bio-Chemistry OR Industrial Chemistry OR Analytical Chemistry OR Agro-Chemicals and Fertilizers.**
- d 1] Statistics. With Mathematics OR Statistics OR Applied Mathematics shall be held eligible for **admission to M.Sc. in Statistics.**
- f 1] Applied Mathematics. With Mathematics shall be held eligible for admission to the **M.Sc. Applied Mathematics.**
- h 1] Environmental Science With Environmental Science OR Botany OR Zoology OR Physics or Chemistry shall be held eligible for **admission to M.Sc. in Environmental Science.**
- i 1] Bio-Technology Science Graduates with Bio-Chemistry/ Botany/ Zoology/ Env. Science/ Horticulture/ Bio-Physics/ Dairy Science/ Bio-Informatics/ Life Sciences/ Microbiology/ Bio-Technology as one of the Optional subjects, B.Sc.(Agriculture) OR B. Pharmacy shall be held eligible for admission to **M.Sc. (Bio-Technology) Course.**
- j 1] Bio-Chemistry
2] Environmental Science Admissions to M.Sc. Bio-Chemistry and M.Sc. Environmental Science courses shall be made on the basis of aggregate percentage of marks of Three Years in three optional subjects. The weight age OR 1% Marks will be given to the candidates who have offered Bio-Chemistry/ Environmental Science as one of the optional subjects at B.Sc. level for seeking admission to



M.Sc. Bio-Chemistry/ Environmental Science respectively.

k 1] Mathematics

A candidate who has passed the B.Sc. Examination of this University or of any other Statutory University recognized as equivalent thereto with Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry subjects may be allowed to seek admission to the **M.Sc. (Mathematics Course)** as external candidate

l 1] Computer Science

A candidate shall be admitted to the **First Year for the Master of Science [Computer Science]** in the Faculty of Science, provided that he / she passed **Computer Science as one of the Optional subjects at B.Sc. level B.E./ Any Other Bachelor's Degree in Computer Science of this University OR** any Other University recognized as equivalent thereto with minimum of **50% of Marks [45% Marks for Reserve Category]**.

In case of vacancies not filled due to non availability of students with above mentioned criteria, the students with B.Sc. Physics/ Electronics/ Mathematics as one of the Optional subjects may also be considered for the admission.

[As per Circular No. Acad/ NP/ Comp. Sci./30/2002 dated 30-07-2002].

m 1] Information Technology

A candidate who has qualified any one of the following Degree [a, b, c] with at least **50% Marks [45% for Reserved Category]** of this University or any other University equivalent thereto shall be admitted to the First Year of **M.Sc. [Information Technology]** Courses [in the **Faculty of Science**] as per merit order of a **Common Entrance Test** for the purpose. B. Sc. Having Mathematics as one of the subject at XII Standard.

B. Sc. Having Mathematics/ Physics/ Computer Science/ I.T./ OR any relevant Computer related recognized subject as one of the subjects.

B.C. Sc. Graduate of Engineering and Technology.

n Master of Science in Conservation of Biodiversity

Bachelor's Degree [10+2+3+4] of Science, Engineering, Agriculture and any other equivalent degree of statutory University.

o Master of Science in Rural Technology

Bachelor's Degree [10+2+3+4] of Science, Engineering, Agriculture and any other equivalent degree of statutory University.

Master of Vocation [02 year course]

a 1] Bio-Technology,

A candidate who has passed Degree in the Faculty of Science or its equivalent, with Bio-Chemistry/ Botany/ Zoology/ Env. Science/ Horticulture/ Bio-Physics/ Dairy Science/ Life Sciences/ Microbiology/ Bio-Technology as one of the Optional subjects.

b 1] Industrial Automation.

B. Sc. Voc. Industrial Automation B.Sc. Physics and Electronics/ B.Ed./ B. Tech. Electronics/ Instrumentation/ E&TC/ Electrical/ Mechanical/ Mechatronics/ Industrial Automation.

c 1] Automobile.

B. Voc. (Automobile)/ B.Sc. (Automobile)/ B.E. / B. Tech. (Automobile/ Mechanical/ Production)

Faculty of Commerce & Management

Master of Commerce [02 year course]

a 1] Commerce

A Candidate shall be admitted to the First Year Course for the Master's degree in the Faculty of Commerce provided that he has passed the Bachelor's Degree examination in the Faculty of Commerce of this University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto with compulsory English as one of the passing subjects, Provided that the condition of passing the bachelor's degree examination with compulsory English shall not apply to a candidate migrating from the jurisdiction of a University in the State of Maharashtra if he seeks admission to a post-graduate Course of this University.

Master of Management [02 year course]



- a 1] Master of Business Administration (International Business) M.B.A. (I.B.)

The Degree of Master Of International Business (M.I.B) shall be conferred on a candidate who has passed a full time course of study of four semester spread over two years of this University and has passed the prescribed examination of M.I.B. course.

A candidate who has passed B.Com. Or B.B.A of this University or from any other University or any other course equivalent thereto and who has scored 50% or more marks at graduate level (45% for reserve category) shall be eligible to take admission to the first semester Master of International Business.

- b 1] Master of Business Administration, (Part Time)

The degree of Master of Business Administration (M.B.A) shall be conferred on a candidate who has perused a full time course of study of four semesters spread over two years of part time course of six semesters spread over three years after taking Bachelor Degree in any faculty of this University and has passed the prescribed examination of M.B.A.

The course of study for the M.B.A. degree shall be full time as well as part time. The full time M.B.A. course shall be of two years consisting of Four Semester and part time course shall be of three years consisting of six semesters. Duration of each semester, both in full time and part time M.B.A. course shall be of 14 weeks from the date of the commencement of the semesters.

Every candidate for the M.B.A. degree shall besides undergoing the course of instructions mentioned above has to undergo practical work/ sessional work by way of case studies, project report, factory visits. Mid-semester test, seminars, tutorials and assignments to the satisfaction of the teacher concerned and shall be required to maintain a record of it.

For passing in a paper, a candidate must secure 30% marks in each passing head (Theory and sessional both) and a minimum of 40% of marks (Theory and sessional taken together) prescribed for that paper if a candidate fails to secure 40% marks in a paper, then he can reappear for the theory exam to improve. For passing the final examination, a candidate should pass all the papers prescribed for the MBA course and should secure 50% of the aggregate marks prescribed for the entire course. A candidate who passes the individual paper but fails to secure 50% of the marks in aggregate, he may choose to reappear for any paper (theory) of the MBA course.

A Candidate shall not be allowed to appear for the semester examination unless the head of the Institution or University Department, in consultation with the concerned teacher, certifies the completion of the sessional/ practical's work.

No candidate shall be allowed to transfer his admission from full time to part time course and vice versa.

All the candidates intending to seek enrolment to full time or part time M.B.A. course will have to give the undertaking that they will observe the teaching and evolution Schedule consisting of Class Teaching, Sessional and practical Work. In-Plant Training and Project work.

The minimum marks for passing the examination for each semester shall be 30% in each theory and sessional and 40% taken for all the courses of the semester.

To be eligible for promotion to the second year of the programme, a student of full time MBA Programme, must clear successfully at least 12 out of the 16 paper offered during first year (first and second semester) of the programme. However appearance at the first semester and third semester examination is compulsory for promotion to next semester.



- c 1] Master of Tourism & Travel Management (M.T.T.M.)
- The degree of Master of Tourism & Travel Management (M.T.T.M.) shall be conferred on a candidate who has passed a full time course of study of four semesters after taking his bachelor's degree any faculty of this University or any other University recognized as equivalent to a degree of this University in any faculty and has passed the prescribed examination of M.T.T.M.
- The course of study for the degree of M.T.T.M. shall be full time intensive course extending over four semesters i.e. two academic years.
- Every candidate for the M.T.T.M. degree shall besides undergoing the courses of instruction mentioned below, do practical work by way of case studies, project report, Trip report, Training report and Viva-Voce, under the guidance of the teachers to the satisfaction of the teachers concerned and shall be required to maintain a record of it. Every candidate shall also participate in seminars organized by the concerned teachers & the department.
- d 1] Water & Land Management
- The Name of the Course shall be "Master Of Management Science (Water and Land Management)
- A candidate seeking admission to M.M.S. (Water & Land Management), should have passed the Bachelor Degree Examination in any Faculty of this University or any other recognized university with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate.
- e D.B.M.
- A candidate who has passed Degree in the Faculty or its equivalent.
- f P.G.D.H.A.M.
- Any steam of Medical Graduate or Medical Experience
- g P.G.D.H.S.M.
- Any steam of Medical Graduate or Medical Experience
- h M.B.A. Executive
- Executive Experience of 3 Years
- i M.B.A. Duel
- A candidate who has passed Degree in the Faculty or its equivalent.

Master of Humanities [02 year course]

- a 1) Marathi,
2) Hindi,
3) English,
4) Urdu,
5) Sanskrit
- A candidate shall be admitted to the first year Course for the Master's degree in the Faculty of Arts or social Science as the case may be provided he satisfies the following the following conditions.
- He must have passed the Bachelor's Degree examination in the concerned Faculty of this University or an Examination of other University recognized as equivalent thereto. However, the candidate seeking admission in a subject at his Bachelor's Degree level.
- Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing para:-
- A candidate who has passed the Bachelor's degree Examination in any Faculty in Compulsory Language/ second Language shall be eligible for admission to the M.A. Course in the respective language.
- b 1] Pali & Buddhism
- A candidate who has passed the bachelors degree examination in any of the faculties and who happens to be Buddhist monk or has passed an examination recognized as equivalent thereto, with 40% marks in B. A. (Hons.) and 45% marks in B.A. (Pass) examination respectively with any one of pali, Sanskrit, prakrit, history, Ancient, Indian History and Asian Studies, Philosophy, Psychology, Political Science, Sociology, Linguistics and any of the Mordern Indian Languages as elective or optional subjects may be held eligible for admission to M. A. (pali) course.
- A candidate who has passed the Bachelor's degree Examination in any Faculty in Compulsory Language/ second Language shall be eligible for admission to the M.A. Course in the respective



language.

c 1] Economics

A candidate shall be admitted to the first year course for the Master's degree in the Faculty of Arts or Social Science as the case may be provided he satisfies the following conditions- He must have passed the Bachelor's Degree examination in the concerned faculty of this University or an Examination of other University recognized as equivalent thereto. However, the candidate seeking admission in a subject at M.A. should have studied the same subject at his Bachelor's Degree level.

Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing Para:-

A candidate who has passed the B. Com or B. Sc. (Agriculture) or B. Sc. examination with Mathematics as one of the optional subjects may be held eligible for admission to the **M. A. (Economics) Course.**

d 1] Psychology

A candidate who has passed the Bachelor's degree examination in any of the faculties may be held eligible for admission to M. A. (Psychology) course subject to the condition that the number of admissions shall not exceed 30 out of which not more than 10 % seats should be allotted to candidates belonging to faculties other than Arts, Social Sciences and Science.

e 1] Sociology

He must have passed the Bachelor's Degree examination in the concerned faculty of this University or an Examination of other University recognized as equivalent thereto. However, the candidate seeking admission in a subject at M.A. should have studied the same subject at his Bachelor's Degree level.

A candidate who has passed the B.S.W. Examination from this University or any other University may be held eligible for admission to **M. A. Sociology course.**

f 1] History

He must have passed the Bachelor's Degree examination in the concerned faculty of this University or an Examination of other University recognized as equivalent thereto. However, the candidate seeking admission in a subject at M.A. should have studied the same subject at his Bachelor's Degree level.

A candidate who has passed the B.F.A. Examination with History of this University may be held eligible for admission to **M.A. History Course.**

g 1] Geography

He must have passed the Bachelor's Degree examination in the concerned faculty of this University or an Examination of other University recognized as equivalent thereto. However, the candidate seeking admission in a subject at M.A. should have studied the same subject at his Bachelor's Degree level.

A candidate who has passed the B. Sc. Examination with Geography as one of the optional Subjects may be held eligible for optional subject may be held eligible for admission to the **M. A. Geography course.**

h 1] Political Science

He must have passed the Bachelor's Degree examination in the concerned faculty of this University or an Examination of other University recognized as equivalent thereto. However, the candidate seeking admission in a subject at M.A. should have studied the same subject at his Bachelor's Degree level.

A Candidate who has passed the B.A. with Political Science from this University or any other University may be held eligible for admission to M. A. Public Administration course and a candidate who has passed the B. A. with Public Administration from this University or any other University may be held eligible for admission to **M. A. Political Science Course.**

i 1] Thoughts of Mahatma Phule & Dr. B. R. Ambedkar

A candidate who has passed the Bachelor's Degree examination in any Faculty of this University or an examination of any other University in India and abroad recognized as equivalent there to may be held eligible for admission to **M. A. on the Thoughts of Mahatma Phule and Dr. Ambedkar.**

A candidate who has passed the M.A. examination of this



University or a Statutory University recognised as equivalent thereto may be permitted to take up course for M.A. Degree in any other subject, provided that he fulfils the conditions laid down in O.473 (i)

- j 1] Archaeology
2] Liberal Arts

A candidate who has passed the Bachelor's Degree examination in any Faculty of this University or an examination of any other University in India and abroad recognized as equivalent there to may be held eligible for admission to **M. A. Archaeology / Liberal Arts.**

- k Master of Rural Studies in Socio-Cultural & Political Aspects Any Bachelor Degree of Statutory University or Any Equavalent.
- l Master of Rural Studies in Rural Economics, Banking & Industry Any Bachelor Degree of Statutory University or Any Equavalent.

Master of Interdisciplinary [02 year course]

- a 1] Fine Art

A candidate for being eligible for admission to the Master of Fine Arts degree course (by research) in the branches of 1.painting 2. Portraiture 3. Print-making (Graphic art) a working teacher in the constituent/affiliated colleges of this or any other University imparting instruction in above mentioned subjects and must have passed:-

The BFA degree from any University of the Government Diploma in Drawing and Painting of the Government of Maharashtra or an equivalent thereto, for being eligible for admission to the MFA degree by research in the Specialization prescribed for MFA degree by research.

And must have thereafter obtained five years experience of teaching to the classes leading to the BFA degree in any University from the Maharashtra state or the Government Diploma in Art awarded by Maharashtra State. Preference will be given candidate from Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University affiliated Colleges.

- b 1] Music

A candidate who has passed the Bachelor's degree Examination in any of the Faculties and Sangeet Visharad Examination or Sangeet Alankar Examination or Sangeet Shiksha Visharad Examination or B.A. with Music as a main or subsidiary subject or B.A. with entire Music of any University may be held eligible for admission to **M. A. Music** course.

- c 1] Mass Communication and Journalism

The duration of the course of M.A. (Mass communication & Journalism) shall be of two academic years of four Semesters.

A candidate must pass the Entrance Test, followed by Group Discussion and Personal Interview (GDPI). Entrance Test Will be of 70 Marks & GD&PI shall carry 20 marks. 10 marks will be for media experience of any braches print, electronic, adverting, new media etc.

A candidate who has passed Bachelor's Degree in Fine arts or its equivalent along with Diploma in Drawing and Painting of Government of Maharashtra or its equivalent. For Master of Fine Arts degree course (by research) in the branches of 01.Painting 02. Portraiture 03. Print-making (Graphic art): An approved teacher working in the constituent/ affiliated college of this or any other University imparting instruction in above mentioned subjects and must have passed Bachelor's Degree in Fine Arts or its equivalent along with minimum 05 years teaching experience

- e 1] Performing Art
- along with Diploma in Drawing and Painting of Government of Maharashtra or its equivalent.
- He Must have passed the Bachelor degree examination in any faculty of this University or of any University/Institute recognized as equivalent thereto. And He must have passed the Bachelor of Dramatics (One Year Bridge Course) Degree.
- OR
- He must have passed the Bachelor of Performing Arts Degree in Theatre of any University.
- OR
- Those who have passed the two years diploma course in dramatics of this University along with graduation in any faculty will get admission directly to the first year of Master of Performing Arts in Theatre Course.
- OR
- Those who have passed the Bachelor degree in any Faculty with dramatics as one of the optional subjects will get admission directly to the first year of Master of Performing Arts in Theatre Course.
- f 1] Social Work
- A candidate shall be considered eligible for admission to first year of Master of Social Work course if she/he has satisfied the following conditions:-
- She/ he Must have passed the Bachelor's Degree Examination in any faculty of this University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto with at least 40% marks.
- She/ he must have passed P.G. Degree Examination of this or any other recognized University.
- The Degree of Master of Social Work shall be conferred on a candidate who has pursued a regular course of study of Master of Social Work consisting of two years i.e. four semesters, has satisfactory conduct and who has passed all the examinations prescribed for Master of Social Work Course.
- g 1] Yoga
- Graduate in Yoga from recognize University
- OR
- Any graduate with Yoga subject
- OR
- Any graduate in any faculty from Recognize University with Diploma in Yoga from Recognise University.
- OR
- Any graduate in any faculty from recognized University with Diploma in Yoga or Certificate course in Yoga from recognized Institution
- And
- A Candidate who will pass Entrance Test for this M.A. in YOGA course (Entrance Test will include theory and Practical's of Yoga)
- h 1] Lib. & Information Science
- A candidate who has passed Bachelors Degree in any discipline or an Examination equivalent thereto of any Faculty will be admitted to the First Year [First Semester] of Master of Library and Information Science [M.L.I.S.] course as per merit.
- Maximum number of sets for the course should not exceed 12.50 % of the seats for the course will be allotted to the candidates, having experience of working in a recognized library for not less than three years after passing the Bachelor of Library and Information Science Degree/Library Science Diploma in Library Science and 50% seats shall be allotted to the fresh candidates.
- In case seats are vacant for want of deputed in service candidates, the seats shall be filled in with the fresh candidates.

- 03 Other State (Other than Maharashtra) **10% Seats**-Candidates passing Qualifying Exam. From Outside Maharashtra shall be treated as Other State University, Candidate.

- 01 Assignment of Merit Number - All the eligible Candidates who have submitted Application Form on or before the last date specified for the submission of Application Form for Admission through Entrance Test shall be assigned a merit number.
- a The merit list shall be prepared on the basis of Entrance Test score only.
- b If the Entrance Marks are equal then the merit will be decide through UG aggregate score
- c If UG Marks are same then the merit will be decide through Marks of 12th Std.
- d If 12th Marks are same then merit will be decide through Marks of 10th Std.
- 08 Allotment of seats under Entrance Test shall be made as per rule and regulation of Government of Maharashtra and University:-**
